



# HAMMOCK INSTRUCTIONS

## SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

1. Do not exceed the maximum load.
2. Do not climb into hammock feet first.
3. Do not dive into or jump about in hammock.
4. Do not stick your head through the end strings.
5. Do not pull yourself up by the rod (hammock chairs).
6. Keep end strings as straight as possible, do not twist.
7. Do not use damaged or weakened hammock hanging accessories.
8. Hammocks are not designed for swinging.
9. Do not leave children unattended in hammock or near hammock.
10. Hammock fabrics and accessories will become worn over time and use.  
Always check the loading capacity before use.
11. When installing always check with a qualified builder if unsure of safety.
12. If possible, only use the hammock on floors with shock-absorbing properties such as carpet or outdoor grass to minimise the risk of injury in case of falling out of the hammock.

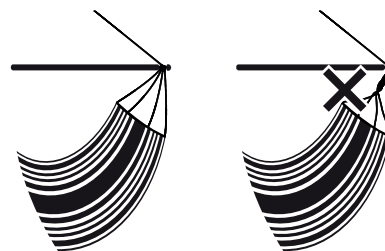
# HAMMOCK INSTRUCTIONS

At Two Trees we know the importance of spending time relaxing. That's why we've developed a range of quality hammocks and convenient accessories that come with easy to follow installation instructions so you will be relaxing in no time.

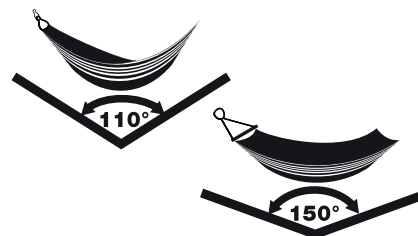


## THINGS TO CONSIDER

- Do not twist or knot suspension cords when hanging.



- Depending on the hammock the angle will vary. Conventional hammocks are hung with sag, rod hammocks are hung taut.



- Hammocks will stretch by 5-10%. It is recommended to use rope first, so that adjustments can be made after each use to keep you and your hammock comfortable.



- For rod hammocks, do not pull yourself up by the rod.

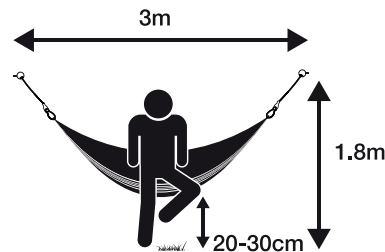


## HOW TO HANG YOUR HAMMOCK

To hang your Two Trees hammock you will require two fixed points, such as trees, beams, posts, or dyna bolts into brick walls. Consult a qualified builder if unsure. Never use a free standing brick wall to hang your hammock.

Your Two Trees hammock will require a minimum of 3 metres between fixing points to get the ideal shape. Rope may be needed to attach one end of the hammock, it is recommended to use a double piece to avoid the hammock twisting.

Hang the hammock loops at roughly the same height. When the hammock is in use it should sit 20-30cm above the ground.



**Temporary installations:** For temporary installations, such as trees or beams, we recommend using the Two Trees hammock hanging kit or universal frame.

1. Place the cord around the pole or tree, then thread through the figure eight hook.



3. Repeat process for other side of hammock. Ensure both hooks are secure, place hammock ends over hooks.

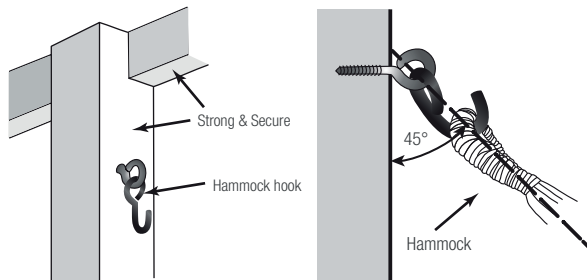


2. Thread the cord through the clamp hook and secure at desired length.



## Permanent installations:

We recommend using the Two Trees screw eye and hook. Always check with your qualified builder if unsure of safety. For sturdy masonry walls (not air/hollow/single brick, besser block, or free standing walls) a 10mm dyna bolt with large washer and rope can be used.

## HOW TO RELAX IN YOUR HAMMOCK

1. Open the fabric in the centre of the hammock and sit in the middle as you would in a chair.
2. Gently lie back on a diagonal with your head on the edge of the hammock.
3. Bring your feet in and stretch them out, so you are lying on a diagonal. This is the traditional way to relax in a classic style hammock.
4. For maximum comfort in rod hammocks lie lengthways.

**NOTE:** Do not climb into your hammock feet first.

## CARING FOR YOUR HAMMOCK

To prolong the lifespan of your Two Trees hammock we always recommend bringing the hammock inside when not in use, as the sun and rain will deteriorate the fabric over time. If using near the sea it is important to rinse regularly.

Care instructions will vary depending on the construction and style of your hammock. You will find these care instructions sewn into the seam of each hammock. A copy of these instructions can also be found on our website.

## STORING YOUR HAMMOCK

When storing your Two Trees hammock make sure hammock is clean and completely dry.

To prevent tangles in classic style hammocks, place a knot in each end string. Fold the hammock in half, with end strings together. Then fold the edges of the hammock to the centre, and roll the hammock up starting with the end strings. Store in a dry place.
